**RE: Jackson Area Improvement Project
Temporary Loss of Driveway Access (Madison St)**

Dear Resident:

Please make arrangements to have all necessary vehicles out of your driveway by 6:00 AM on Monday, March 3, 2025.

Beginning Monday, March 3rd, Madison Street from Addison Avenue to Michigan Avenue will be closed to through traffic to allow for the construction of new large-diameter relief storm sewer. During the closure, residents with driveways on Madison Street should still have limited access to their driveways during the workday and should still have full access to their driveways at the end of most workdays. While residents should still be able to get vehicles in and out of driveways during the workday, there may be significant delays while waiting for equipment or materials to clear the area. For this reason, residents are encouraged to remove any necessary vehicles from their driveways between the hours of 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM and park them on adjacent side streets where otherwise permitted. Residents will also be permitted to park overnight on adjacent side streets. A map of permitted parking locations is provided on the reverse of this letter.

The exception to the above is that residents of each house will lose all access to their driveway when the storm sewer installation work is taking place in front of that house's driveway. During this time, the affected property will be without driveway access for several days. The storm sewer installation will be a moving effort, with installation starting at the intersection of Michigan and Madison and proceeding west on Madison Street to Addison Avenue. Residents at the east end of the area will be the first to fully lose driveway access, but will regain it as construction continues west, while residents at the west end will be the last to fully lose access. As the storm sewer installation work progresses, the engineer and contractor will communicate with individual residents to inform them of the pending loss of access.

The road closure is expected to last approximately two months. The closure is necessary to accommodate the installation of the new large-diameter relief storm sewer on Madison Street, which is part of the larger Jackson Area Improvement Project being undertaken by the village. The 6-foot diameter sewer pipes will be installed at depths of up to 20 feet. The size of the storm sewer trench and the size of the equipment needed to excavate it unfortunately make it impossible to maintain normal traffic and driveway access on Madison Street during this phase of the project.

We recognize that this closure with its extended timeframe will have a significant impact on residents, and we apologize in advance for this inconvenience. Anyone with special needs is asked to notify us so that the contractor can be made aware, and accommodation can be made.
