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RE: North Princeton Avenue Improvement Project

Dear Resident:

Construction of the **North Princeton Avenue Improvement Project** has now reached the point that the contractor is ready to begin installing new curb and gutter and driveway aprons. This work is tentatively scheduled to begin on _____ . During this time, crews will be setting a string line and preparing the roadway for curb installation. This work will be followed by the pouring of the new concrete curb and gutter. Driveway apron work is also expected to take place during this time.

In order to allow this work to take place, residents will not have access to their driveways for a period of approximately two weeks, weather and other circumstances permitting. During this time, residents will be allowed to park during the day and overnight on side streets, where permitted, and will be allowed to park overnight on North Princeton Avenue, where permitted, between the hours of 5:00 PM and 6:00 AM. Please see the list of locations approved for parking on the reverse of this letter. The Villa Park Police Department will be notified of the need for this parking situation, and should accommodate residents accordingly. **We ask that you please make arrangements to have all necessary vehicles out of your driveway by 6:00 AM on _____ .**

We fully understand that this work will be one of the most inconvenient portions of the project for residents, but would like to emphasize that this will mark a substantial move towards completion of the project. After the curb and driveway improvements are complete, reconstruction of the pavement is expected to begin.

We also ask that any residents with special needs contact us so that we can accommodate them as best as possible. We thank you for your continued patience, especially during this period of the project. If you have any questions or would like additional information, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Residents may park during the day and overnight on the following streets, where permitted. The Villa Park Police Department will be notified of the need for overnight parking on these streets, and should accommodate residents accordingly.

* Residents may disregard the “No Parking, 7AM - 9 AM, Mon-Fri” signs on the south side of Terrace Street.

Residents may also park on North Princeton Avenue between Terrace and Ridge, where permitted, between the hours of 5:00 PM and 6:00 AM. All vehicles parked on Princeton must be removed from the street by 6:00 AM in order to accommodate construction operations.
